Specialty Camps

Our specialty camps are open to children ages 4 ½ through 12.

Harbor Day Camp

Open to children ages 2 ½ through 9, this fun filled camp includes activities such as art, music, sports, dance, computers, water play and more! (Children will be appropriately divided into groups according to age and interests.)

Afternoon Adventures Aftercare!

A wonderful option to continue the day, this aftercare program runs from 12pm until 3:00 pm. Children taking part in this extended day program should pack a lunch and drink. **Please note, The Harbor School is a nut free school.**

Required Health Forms

Upon receipt of your camp registration and payment, you will receive by mail the health forms (required by law) to be completed and returned to Harbor prior to your child's first day of camp.

Food/Allergies/Medical Health

If your child has a food allergy and/or an outdoor allergy (bees, pollen etc...) or a medical condition, the proper paperwork **MUST** be completed and signed by the parents and the child's doctor prior to the child's first day of camp. Harbor will provide morning and afternoon snacks and beverages. If your child will not be able to consume the snacks that are offered (Wheat Thins, Animal, Ritz and Graham crackers) due to an allergy, please contact our Camp Director.

Payment/Refund/Cancelation

Please submit payment at time of registration. For refunds, we require a minimum of four (4) weeks notice (from camp start date). Please note the \$50 Administrative fee is nonrefundable. Please contact the Camp Director if you are registering your child for any Flex Days and/or hours.

The Harbor School reserves the right to cancel any under enrolled programs.

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Pick Up Procedure

Parents are asked to stay in their cars and pull up to the circle for the 12noon pick up. A camp instructor will escort children to the car. Parents should not leave their car in the circle at any time. OR if preferred, parents may park their car and walk to the front door to pick up their child. For pick ups after 12noon, parents should park their car in a parking spot and enter the through the front doors to pick up their child.

If another person, not listed on the Student's Information Form, will be picking up your child, you must advise Harbor by phone, email or written note. Photo identification by the authorized pickup person is required.

Health and Safety

The Harbor School is a nut-free school. Any food or beverage found to contain nut/nut products will be disposed of.

Bike Day

For children participating in the weekly Bike Day, all children must wear helmets. There is to be no sharing of bikes/trikes or scooters or helmets.

Diapers/Potty Trained

All campers must be potty trained (no pull ups please) in order to attend Harbor's camp.

HARBOR SPECIALITY CAMPS DESCRIPTIONS

Abracadabra Magic Camp

Master Magician Tim Kottcamp is a very popular magician in the DC area for children of all ages. He not only performs unbelievable magic tricks, but he also teaches magic classes as well. He will help build your child's imagination and self confidence by teaching your children magic. Students will learn a variety of magic tricks as well as the art of presentation skills and comedy. Caroline Ferrante Grossman is back and brings more than a decade of creative drama experience from Northwestern University and the Sundance Theater Institute. At this camp your child will be introduced to the joy of creative world of drama. Children will also develop backdrop projections that integrate technology into this unique re-telling. These activities include soccer, t-ball, fitness (speed and agility), tennis, basketball, games and more! If your child loves sports, games and fun... this is the camp for them!
